

Burns Township Regular Board Meeting, May 8, 2019

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. At 7:30pm.

Roll Call, Board members present Adams, Bowers, Glass, Howard, Riley.

Agenda Approval, Adams moved, Glass seconded. To approve agenda. Ayes 5, Nays 0. Motion carried.

Opened refuse – recycling bid from Republic Services

Public Comment: Lloyd Kilbreath, Everett Heath & Michael Crawford spoke in opposition to the refuse & recycling special assessment.

Assessor Report: Diane Dowler was absent.

County Commissioner Report: Jeremy Root gave the commissioners report. Jeremy commented on the failure of the bond to build a new jail proposal and the possible impact on the County's budget.

Planning Commission Report: Shirley Riley gave an update on upcoming meeting May 29th at 7:00.

Old Business:

Refuse/Recycling- We have received opposition to the special assessment in excess of 20% therefore per act 188 we will not be moving forward with the special assessment until such time we receive 50% support for the special assessment. The attorney has provided us with the petition that is to be used for collecting the 50% support. We will be putting together a notice to send to residents updating them on the status of the special assessment.

We received three bids for replacing the parking lot. We will hold a workshop May 29th at 6:00pm to discuss the bids.

2019 road projects were discussed, at this time we are keeping the total of projects at \$192,982.60.

New Business:

Shiawassee County Community Development Planning Commission – Proposed Ordinance Amendments was distributed and will be discussed at the June meeting.
